ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

HUNTERS FOR YOUTH

We, the undersigned residents of Custer County, Nebraska, desiring to form a nonprofit corporation under the *Nebraska Nonprofit Corporation Act, Neb. Rev. Stat. Sections 21-1901 to 21-19,177*, do hereby certify:

ARTICLE ONE:
NAME

The name of the corporation shall be: HUNTERS FOR YOUTH.

ARTICLE TWO
TYPE OF CORPORATION

The corporation is a public benefit corporation.

ARTICLE THREE
INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT

The initial registered office of the corporation is 544 South 10th Avenue, Broken Bow, NE 68822-2460, and the name of its initial registered agent at that address is Jasen J. Rudolph.

ARTICLE FOUR
PURPOSE

The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, or scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE FIVE
MEMBERS

The corporation will have members.

ARTICLE SIX
EARNINGS

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation

for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in ARTICLE FOUR above. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of the corporation.

ARTICLE SEVEN
DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS UPON DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution of the corporation, and after paying or making provisions for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, the remaining assets of the corporation will be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
